

Fundamentals of Biomedical Sciences I

In collaboration with the Faculty of Medicine, the University of Toronto School of Continuing Studies now offers **Fundamentals of Biomedical Sciences I**.

This certificate program teaches learners basic biochemistry, physiology, pharmacology, and anatomy. Each course provides a variety of medical perspectives. Learners will develop a foundation in the basic life and health sciences that underlie the discipline of medicine, and all allied health professions. While networking with peers, learners will gain the tools to succeed in graduate or future studies.

Fundamentals of Biomedical Sciences I is designed for a variety of learners, including:

- Those working toward a career in medicine (or a related biomedical or allied health profession)
- Anyone looking to take biomedical science courses to prepare for medical school
- Learners who are interested in building basic knowledge and skills, while gaining exposure to one of the world's great medical and research centres
- International students (both post-secondary and high school) who are interested in completing health science courses in English, in advance of entering a health science program at an English speaking university
